- Via Tram Lines A and B – stop: La Plage
- Via bus Lines 1 and 4 – stop: S. de Champlain
- By bike: there is secured bicycle parking at Parking de la Plage

#### Access to the village

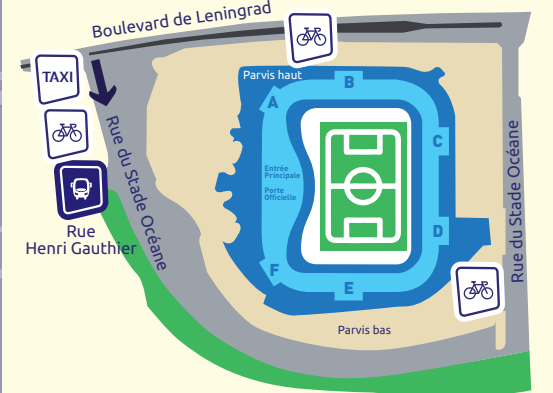
- 3 entrances with security checks
- 3 levels of security control: a visual inspection of jackets and authorised bags, metal detector security screening and body searches.

### STADIUM ACCESS



- The Stade Océane car parks are not open to the public. You can get to the stadium by catching a free shuttle, walking or cycling.
- The square on the upper side of the stadium grounds (in the blue zone) is located within the security perimeter.
- To gain access into the security perimeter, you must show your ticket. You will be subject to 3 levels of security control: a visual inspection of jackets and authorised bags, metal detection screenings and body checks.

### ITEMS PROHIBITED IN THE STADIUM AND AT THE FIFA FAN EXPERIENCE



- There is a free left luggage facility available at the stadium.
- If anyone in possession of an unauthorised object refuses to hand it over to stadium staff, entry to the stadium will be refused.
- This list is non-exhaustive and may be subject to change upon request from the organisers.
- All ticket holders are likely to be filmed within the stadium and upon entry for video surveillance purposes.

## FREE SHUTTLES

leaving from Le Havre, Montivilliers and Gonfreville-l'Orcher (to the Stade Océane terminus)

### GETTING TO THE STADE OCÉANE

- Departures from Le Havre bus station (Cours La Fayette): from bay D every 10 minutes starting 3 hours before kick off (last shuttle 10 minutes before kick off)
- Departures from Montivilliers train station (Place Général Leclerc de Hauteclouque): every 25 minutes starting 3 hours before kick off (last shuttle 30 minutes before kick off)
- Departures from Montivilliers Champ de Foire (Rue du Champ de Foire, in front of the high school): every 50 minutes

- starting 3 hours before kick off (last shuttle 30 minutes before kick off)
- Departures from Gonfreville-l'Orcher Camp-Dolent (av. Jacques Eberhard - Piscine Gd'O): every 25 minutes starting 3 hours before kick off (last shuttle 30 minutes before kick off)

- Departures from Relais Jules Durand Le Havre car park (170 Jules Durand bld): every 15 minutes starting 3 hours before kick off (last shuttle 10 minutes before kick off)

### GETTING BACK FROM THE STADE OCÉANE

- Shuttles depart after the match from rue Henri Gauthier (following the same itineraries)
- An additional shuttle runs between the Stade Océane terminus and Dollemard (stopping at Gares (the main stations), Hôtel de Ville (city Hall), Sanvic and Bléville).

- There are also connections to the tram network and train station. Single ticket price: 1.80€.

## UNMISSABLE LANDMARKS

- THE PERRET SHOW FLAT**  
Discover the developments made by the Perret studio to rehouse inhabitants after the war.
- SAINT-JOSEPH'S CHURCH**  
Like a beacon of light in the heart of the city, this reconstructed church, designed by Auguste Perret, features 12,768 stained glass windows.
- CITY HALL**  
With its 72-metre tall tower and extensive building made up of concrete columns, the city hall is one of Le Havre's most emblematic structures following the city's reconstruction.
- HÔTEL DUBOCAGE DE BLÉVILLE MUSEUM**  
This former private mansion, which belonged to a corsair seafaring merchant, houses collections connected to the history of Le Havre and its port.
- CATÈNE DE CONTAINERS**  
36 containers make up this work of art, created in 2017 by Vincent Ganivet to celebrate the city's 500th anniversary.
- THE SHIP OWNER'S MANSION**  
Through its collections, décor and architecture revolving around a skylight, this 18th century house is emblematic of Le Havre's maritime history and its trading past.
- LES BAINS DES DOCKS**  
This aquatic centre, inspired by Roman thermal baths, was designed by architect Jean Nouvel.
- THE BEACH AND ITS HUTS**  
Emblematic symbols of Le Havre's beach, the huts were painted bright colours during A Summer in Le Havre 2017 thanks to the imagination of graphic designer Karel Martens.
- THE MuMa ANDRÉ MALRAUX MUSEUM OF MODERN ART**  
Situating in the heart of an exceptional glass and steel building opposite the entrance to the port, this museum houses the second largest collection of impressionist artwork in France.
- THE HANGING GARDENS**  
Experience sensorial discoveries and explore the plant world at this 17-hectare site overlooking the Baie de Seine with remarkable views of the sea, port and city.
- THE NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM**  
A great family day out and journey of discovery into the animal, plant and mineral worlds.
- LE VOLCAN**  
This masterpiece by Brazilian architect Oscar Niemeyer houses two auditoriums and a library, often frequented by locals.
- UP#3**  
Playing with the perspectives of the Porte Océane, in 2017 artists Sabina Lang and Daniel Baumann installed a white structure on the beach in line with the existing buildings.
- JUSQU'AU BOUT DU MONDE**  
Like a totem at the foot of the Côte d'Albâtre's cliffs, this sculpture by artist Fabien Mérelle was created in 2018.
- SAINT-VINCENT AND THE BEACH**  
  - A village atmosphere within the city with stylish seaside villas
  - Several fashion, interior design and gourmet food shops
  - Umpteen beach and seaside restaurants with a sea view
  - The Bout du monde, situated between the sea and cliffs: an unexpected spot for Fabien Mérelle's art installation
